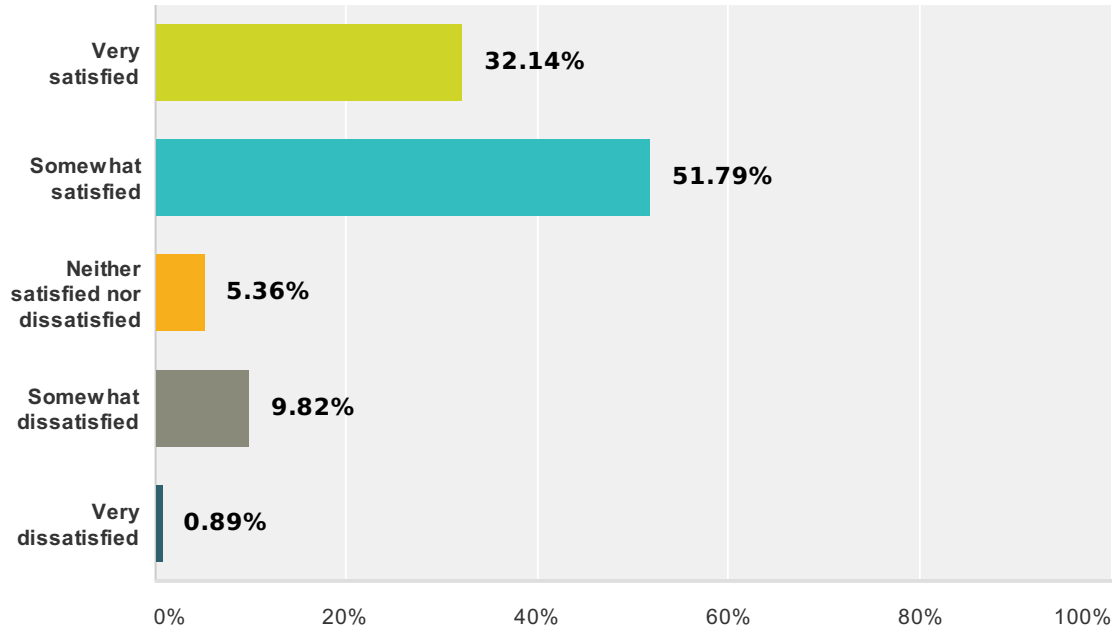


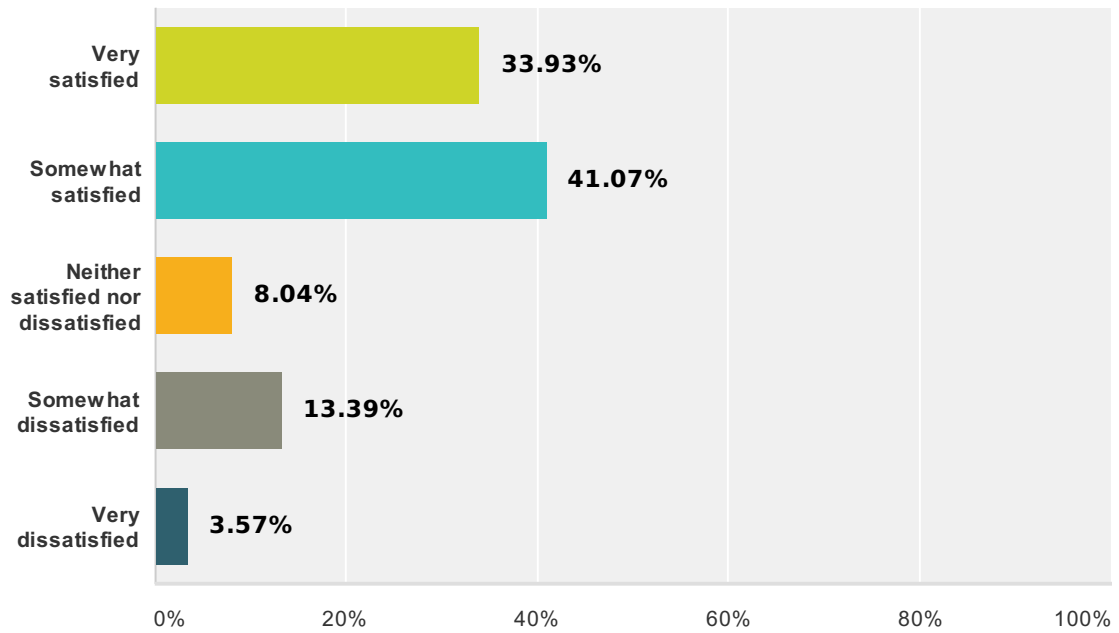
Q1 Thinking about the 2013 season overall how satisfied were you?

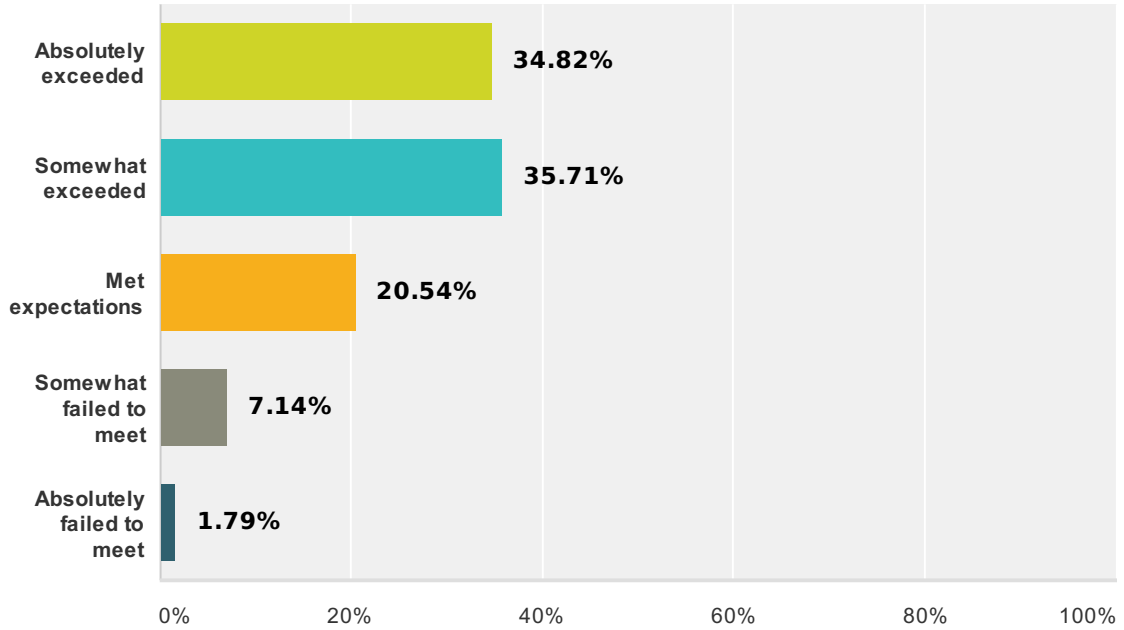
Q2 Thinking about the equipment, facilities and the overall Junior football environment and culture how satisfied were you?

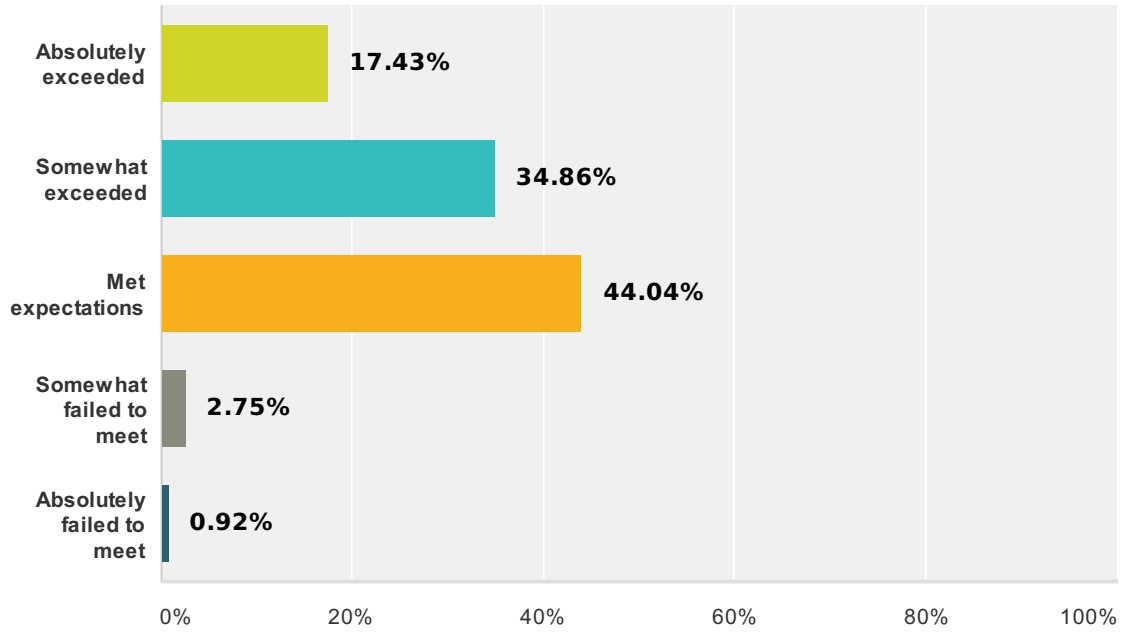
Q3 Thinking about the club volunteers, including coaches, managers and committee members, and their overall performance and conduct how did they rate against your expectations?

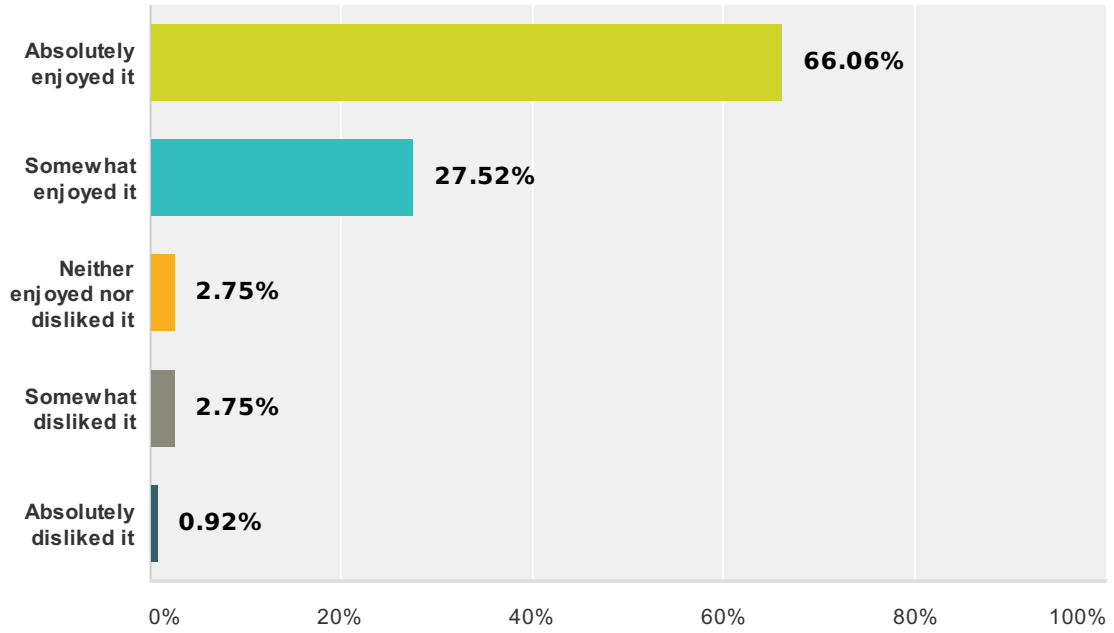
Q4 Thinking about the match day experience, including the style and level of football played, how did it rate against your expectations?

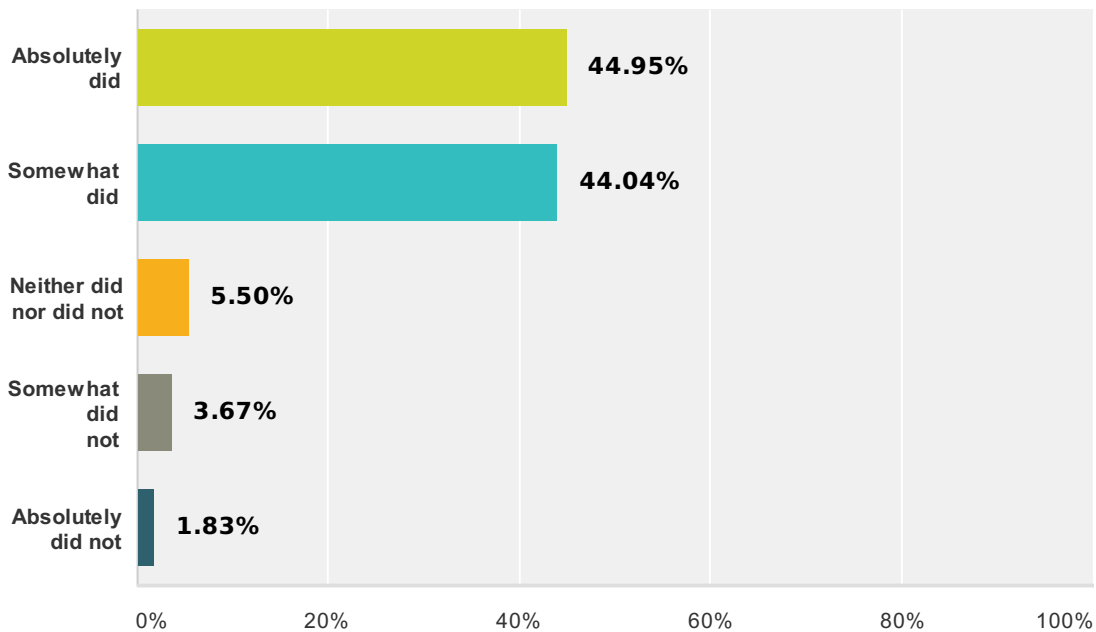

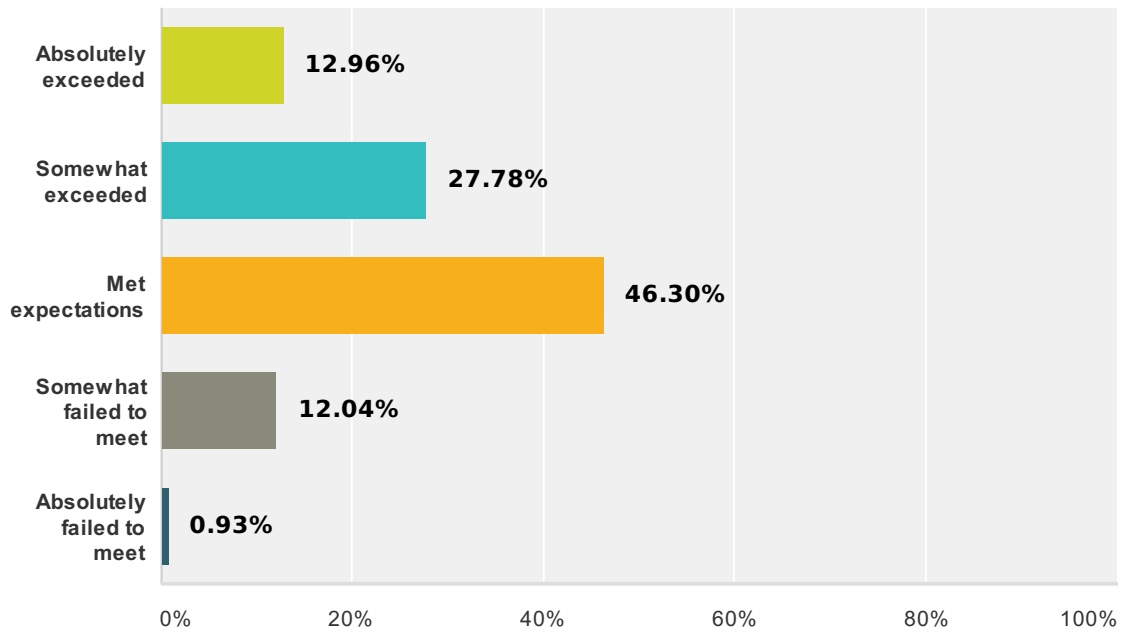
Q6 Did the coaching and games provide opportunity for your child to gain a higher level of skill, ability and understanding of football?

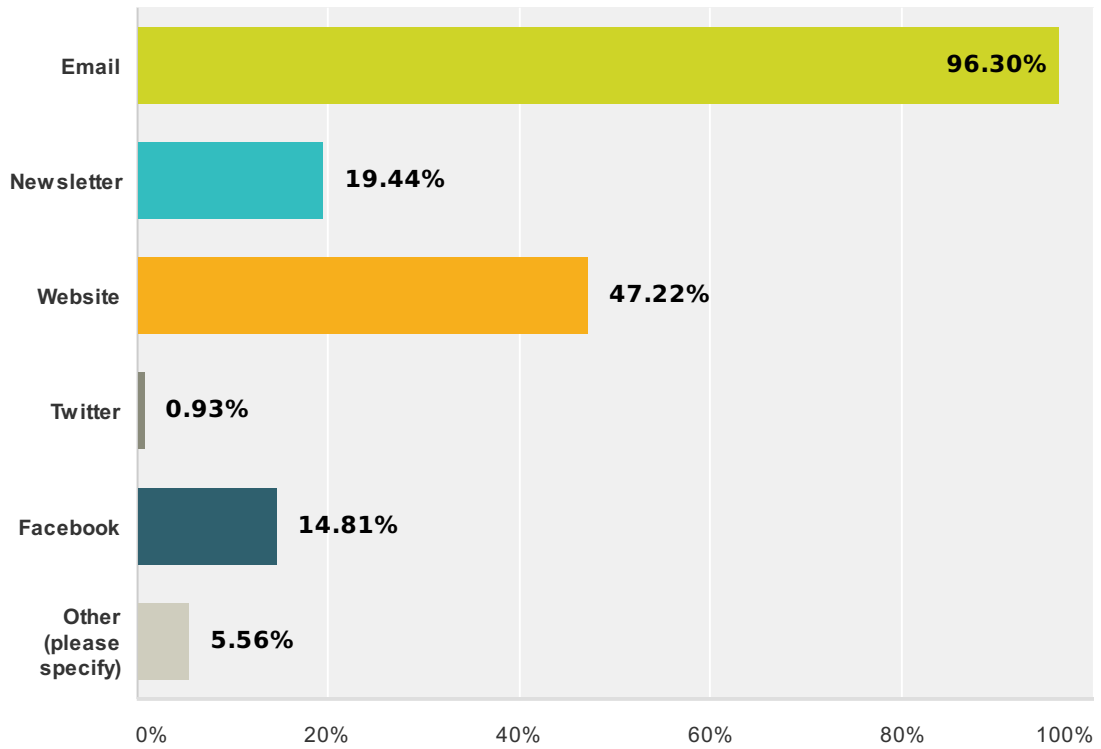
Q7 How well did we meet your expectations with regard to communication and general interactions?

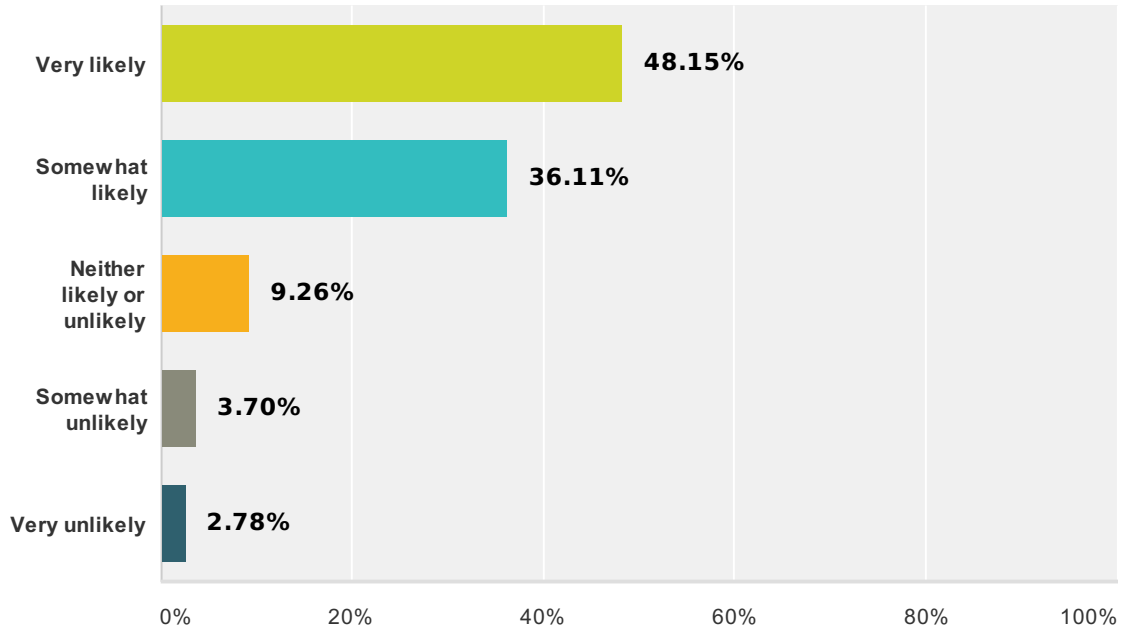
Q8 Which two (2) methods do you prefer most to receive information and updates about club activities and operation?

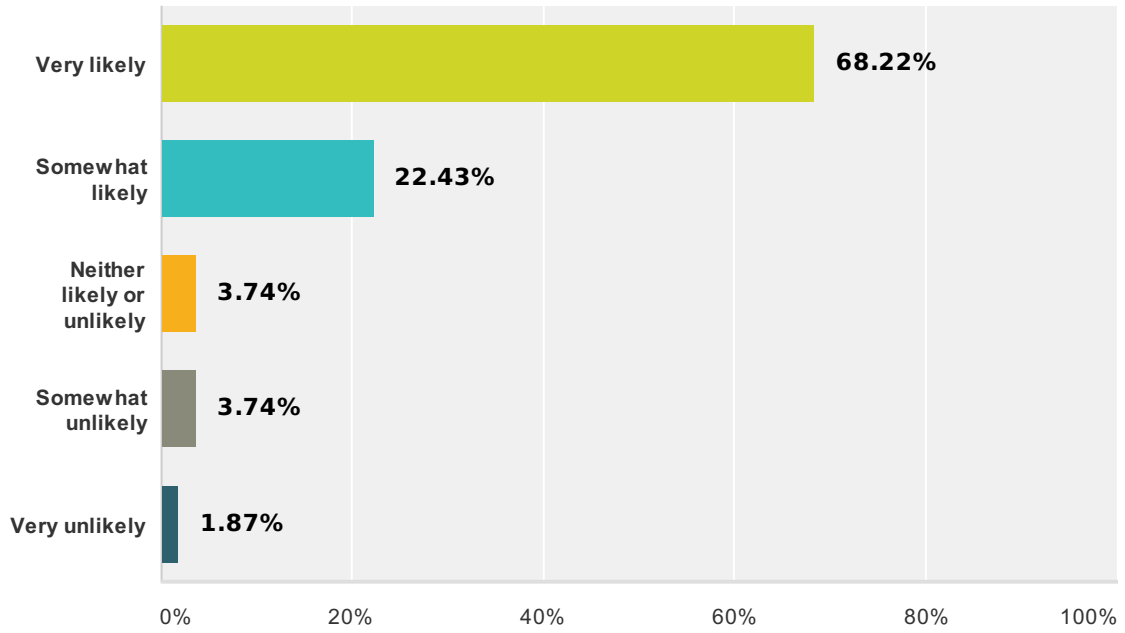
Q9 Thinking about the overall delivery, cost and football culture how likely would you be to recommend The Gap Football Club to others?

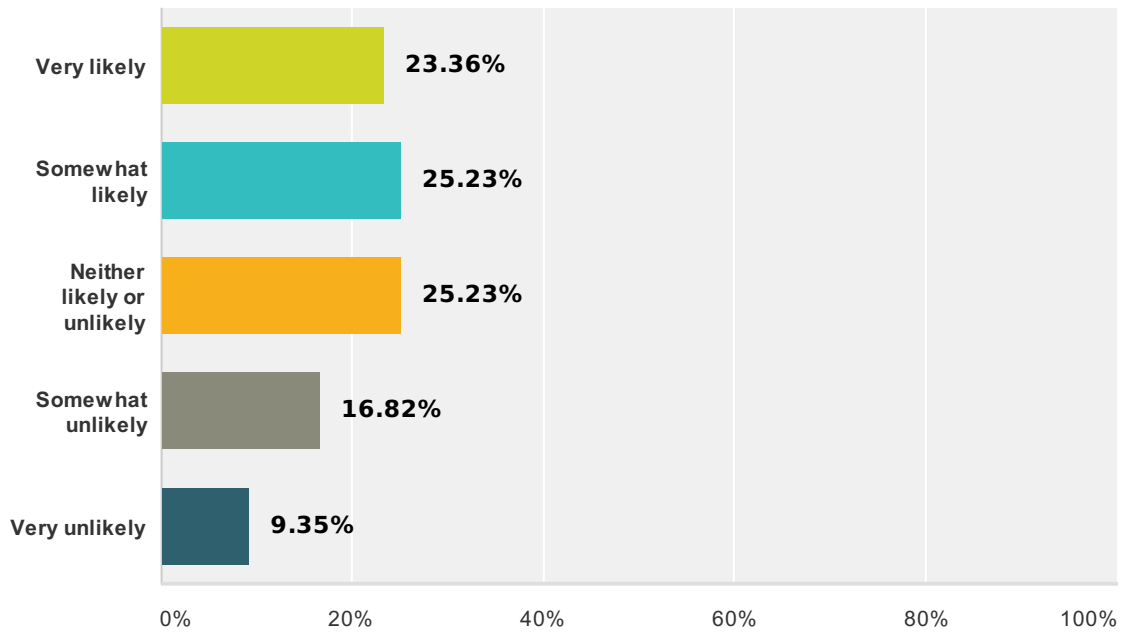
Q10 How likely would you be to register your child with The Gap Football Club again in the future?
